ALLOCATION OF POINTS TOWARD THE 125-REQUIREMENT

Weightlifting Canada Haltérophilie Masters recognizes members who have participated in National and International Competitions. This is done by awarding points for such participation and medal accomplishments. Members who are National or International Technical Officials are also awarded points on an annual basis. Candidates must have acquired 125 points total in order to be eligible for induction into the Hall of Fame. Achieving this status takes a lot of commitment and participation in Weightlifting Competitions,

QUALIFYING ACTIVITIES:

1. The qualifying competitions are Canadian Masters Championships, Canadian Seniors, IMWA World Masters Championships/World Masters Games, World Masters Cup, Commonwealth Masters Championships, North America Cup, Pan Am Masters and a Continental Masters Championships. Members who have participated in the Canadian Seniors or a Continental Masters Championship are expected to contact the National Chair and Hall of Fame Secretary.
2. NTO/ITO points are at the discretion of the WCHM President upon recommendation from the member's Provincial Association President, who must first be approached by the WCHM member.
3. **Provincial Masters and local meets are excluded** due to the nature of this prestigious award for participatory excellence at National and International level competitions.
4. Members participating in a combined championship competition will receive Hall of Fame points for the competition that will produce the greater number of points

RATIONALE FOR THE HALL OF FAME POINT ALLOCATION

1. Members are availing themselves to **more Masters Competitions**.
2. **Recognizing the Canadian Seniors and ITO members of our Federation** enhance our Federation's continued cooperation and support of the CWFHC. Members who have participated in the Canadian Seniors are expected to contact the National Chair and Hall of Fame Secretary.
3. **Involving Provincial Presidents** in recommending their NTO/ITO for Hall of Fame points (commencing in 2021) further increases support of the Provincial Associates of WCH and ensures that the NTO/ITO is offering their services to provincial weightlifting competitions.
4. **Provincial Masters and local meets are excluded** due to the nature of this prestigious award for participatory excellence at National and International level competitions.
5. **Continental Masters Championships are included** as our membership is open to Canadian citizens living abroad and who may wish to enter such competitions in the part of the world in which they are residing. These members must be given an equal opportunity to acquire HOF points. Members who have participated in a Continental Masters Championship are expected to contact the National Chair and Hall of Fame Secretary.
6. Hall of Fame points for the **World Masters Cup will be recognized retroactively** for years 2014, 2015, 2017 and 2019, for participating and winning medals.
