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Preparing for Antidoping Control at the Canadian Masters Weightlifting Championships (CMWC)

1. Athletes must not use the known prohibited substances found here: ([The Prohibited List | World Anti Doping Agency \(wada-ama.org\)](#))
2. Athletes are expected to have completed the WCHM Anti-doping Education Lessons and complete the self-test prior to the Championships. If the CCES Antidoping Course is a requirement, those instructions will be communicated to all members.
3. Athletes will register and pay for participation in the CMWC and affix their signature to the Anti-Doping Compliance on the competition registration form.
4. Athletes who test positive will be directed to the appropriate forms that must be completed. Athletes will be expected to reimburse WCHM, in full or in part, for the cost of any Results Management Fees incurred. Athletes are therefore strongly cautioned against the use of any prohibited substances ([The Prohibited List | World Anti Doping Agency \(wada-ama.org\)](#))

Results Management fees can range from no less than \$500 up to a maximum of \$5000.
